### **AWANA Groups:**

**Cubbies:** 3-4 year olds (start when they are 2 years prior to attending Kindergarten) Cubbies celebrate the spiritual potential of preschoolers by helping them develop respect for God, his Son, and his Word.

Sparks: Kindergarten-2nd grade

Sparks ignites the curiosity of early elementary-age kids to learn about the people and events of the Bible, building a foundation of wisdom for knowing Christ.

### **Truth and Training** (T&T): 3rd - 5th grade

T&T engages kids by answering their questions about God and the Bible, guiding them through this pivotal life stage to grow in Christ's grace.

### **Drop off/Pick up/Security**

A parent or guardian must check-in and check-out kids at the designated area each week. All kids wear a security tag with their name and emergency phone number.

<u>Check in starts at 6:15</u> and allows our teachers to get ready. AWANA ends at 8:00pm. Parents are expected to pick up their child at this time. Each AWANA leader has completed a background check. All leaders will be wearing nametags and volunteer shirts to help easily identify them.

CUBBIES (3-4 year olds) are located in the front building/Temple Christian School.

SPARKS & TnT are located in the back building.

#### All about AWANA:

At the beginning of the club year kids will be given an entrance booklet of general information and material to be memorized. <u>Once they have passed the requirements of this</u> booklet, they will earn a uniform and a handbook. You can expect this on the third week attending.

 Handbook Time/Small Groups are when the kids recite the sections they have learned to their leaders. It is also a wonderful opportunity for leaders to teach the kids the meaning of the verses they have memorized.







\*\*ALL KIDS will do the "all together method" where your child will be assigned a table teacher. This setting allows for discipleship, relationships, and scripture teaching.

If you miss a week, you can catch up at home!

• Large Group Time is when the kids hear a Bible story from God's Word.





• **Game Time** is a fun time to develop good sportsmanship and teamwork.







#### **Awards**

In AWANA your child can earn awards throughout the club year. Most
awards are earned by passing sections in their handbooks. If a child completes a section,
they will receive their award the <u>NEXT week</u> during large group time in front of their class.
Cubbies have award nights throughout the year for parents to attend at the end of the class.



#### **AWANA Uniforms**

- Cubbies will earn a vest after attending three times and apples to iron on for completing verses.
- Sparks will earn a vest after attending three times and earn jewels for completing verses.
- \*NEW\* TnT will be earning a drawstring bag (instead of a green uniform) after attending three times and earn star pins to add to their bag for completing verses.
  - o TnT kids returning may still wear their green uniform or purchase a drawstring bag.

- Wear your uniform/bring your bag and participate in our fun theme nights!
- Pass sections (Scripture memory and activities) in your handbook.
- Participate at game time.
